Classroom Update

Language Arts: Your child has read a story called “A Piece of Home” by Sonia Levitin. Your child is learning about an experience one family had leaving their homeland in Russia and moving to America. Ask you child to tell you about it. Vocabulary words to review include: ***journey, treasure, strange, passport, and Russian.***

Math: Students will measure with cups, tablespoons, teaspoons and read a recipe; subtract a multiple of 10 using mental computation; estimate differences of two digit numbers; show three and four digit numbers using base ten blocks; follow a recipe, set a dial and determine elapsed time.

Special Units of Study: The next few weeks your child will be learning about a different culture. Room 13 will study the Netherlands, Room 12 will study Scotland, Room 14 will study about Japan, and Room 19 will study, “Children Just Like Me.”
